I will take photographs (if permitted) which show the child's learning and keep them together in individual learning assessment books. These are always available for the parent to see and are theirs to take away when their child leaves my setting. The observations will be extremely important as they allow us to plan individual play activities which are designed to specifically support the child's development.

I will make sure the practice is inclusive by:

- Learning about different cultures and faiths and celebrating events like Diwali, Christmas, Eid, Chinese New Year etc
- Positively promote inclusive practice
- Attending regular training courses to further extend my own knowledge and skills
- Creating a positive learning environment as an effective way to encourage children to develop positive attitudes and respect for other people
- Having an open mind and flexible approach and a positive attitude to work
- Having new toys from different cultures and sharing this toy, new food recipes, new song/rhyme
- I will also have different books and photos from different faiths and beliefs



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
