



Sickness policy

If the child becomes unwell the parents will be contacted immediately and asked to collect the child. If parents are unable to collect the emergency contact will be called. If the child is then put onto antibiotics please allow 48 hours before the child comes back into my care as this allows the antibiotics to enter the system.

If you are unsure about whether to bring your child, please ring me and we can discuss the matter together. Please contact me as soon as possible to inform me if your child will not be attending so that we do not become concerned if late.

I operate an inclusive childminding setting, where all children are welcome regardless of their race, religion, culture, sex, ability or disability, social background etc.

There are however certain occasions when it may be necessary to ask a parent to not bring their child to my home for a short period of time. These reasons include:

- If a child is ill with fever
- If a child has a highly infectious condition such as impetigo or conjunctivitis
- If the child has a notifiable disease
- If a child has had a bout of sickness or diarrhea within the last 48 hours
- If a child is on antibiotics that they haven't taken before and it is within the first 3 days of the course (in case of an allergic reaction)

I will contact you if one of my own children is not well, inform you of the illness/symptoms and if I am able to work. This then allows you to make an informed decision as to whether to bring your child or not.

If the unfortunate event that a child has an accident that requires immediate medical attention, 999 will be called or I will take them to my local hospital, whichever is quickest? Parents will be contacted immediately and kept updated until they arrive.
